In **Sunday 8th March and out Friday 13th March.** Non-riding partners need to be social members and can join on the Club's website for \$20. The first ride is on Monday 9th March start location to be advised when numbers are confirmed and details of where attendees are staying.

- **All members must complete the online booking form (ticket in Trybooking) which confirms your camp address, mobile phone number, emergency contacts if single, food donations for the Sunday night meal and morning tea, volunteer jobs, dietary requirements. Note:- Trybooking form will be available in the new year to submit your booking information for the camp.**
- **This form will save you time as no manual form filling in, scanning and emailing back to the organizers.** Then Trybooking gives an instant report. **This saves heaps of time please give it a go. If you get stuck ring Andy 0409376359.** There is no cost to the Club because payment is not made via Trybooking You pay by EFT as normal.

9. IMPORTANT CAMP INFORMATION

- Book your own accommodation and make the necessary payments ASAP.

- Rides will be on sealed roads and supported by a backup vehicle and also provide the morning tea. Safety is important so ride single file on all roads as Nannup roads can be busy with tourists.
- After tea each evening there will be ride briefing for the next day confirming ride start time, ride destinations. Maps to ride leaders and to the backup vehicle driver and volunteers.
- There will also be a roster for volunteers to assist with desert serving, barbecue cooking and clean up duties. This will be drawn up and posted on a notice board at the camp.
